French Broad Wee Heavy-er (NC) \$4.00 \$7.00 \$12.50

This traditional-style Scotch lowland ale is malty, toasty, sweet, with just the right amount of that local Asheville touch.

Guinness Irish Stout (Ireland) \$5.00-20oz \$7.00 \$12.50

Brewed from the same recipe since 1759, Guinness possesses a robust taste, a smooth creamy head, and a rich body.

Harp (Ireland) \$4.00 \$7.00 \$12.50

Bright pale golden; fruity nose; crisp and clean, slightly bitter up front, smooth aftertaste.

Orange Blossom Pilsner (FL) \$4.00 \$7.00 \$12.50

The yeast ferments the sugar in the honey and leaves behind a dry, crisp beer with a delicate orange blossom and honey character.

Oscar Blues Mama's Yellow Pils (CO) \$4.00 \$7.00 \$12.50

Well balanced and light. Just enough hops to allow that pilsner taste, but not too much that it kills your tongue. Just enough to take the edge off, thanks mom, we get it.

Sierra Nevada 50 Year Anniversary Ale (CA) \$4.00 \$7.50 \$12.50

Everyone knows the Sierra Nevada name. Helps us celebrate this with their 50 year anniversary ale. Lighter hopped than it's pale ale counterpart, but at 5.9% ABV you honestly will not mind after just one taste.

Smithwicks (Ireland) \$4.00 \$7.00 \$12.50

Smithwick's is Ireland's number one ale. Its exceptional taste, distinctive color and purity of ingredients make it unique.

Spaten Lager/Oktobertfest (Germany) \$4.00 \$7.00 \$12.50
